1. Preliminary Matters

1.1. Opening, Welcome Address and Organization Matters

The Voting Bureau closes and ZZ Zhang opens the RAGA at 16:30. He welcomes the Assembly. 2.2. Approval of Minutes taker, Vote Counting Officer, Agenda and Minutes





3.2. Treasurer's Reports

Daniel Aellen, Treasurer, delivers his report on the 2021 Accounts:



- In fiscal year 2021, SwissCham Beijing reached a total net revenue of CNY1'440K.
- The total net expenses amounted to CNY1'356K, resulting in a total net profit of CNY84k.
- In 2021, SwissCham Beijing finalized a net profit of **CNY84K**, which was the net result of total net revenue of **CNY1,440K** and total cost of **CNY1,356K**.
- This compares to budgeted profit of CNY1K, as a result of budgeted net revenue of CNY1,305K and budgeted cost of CNY1,304K.
- 2021 total net revenue of CNY1,440K was mainly contributed by:
 - Membership fees: CNY641K
 - Events: CNY688K
 - Products: CNY111K
- Membership payments, especially yearly sponsorship payment, the great success of STD and SSBA payments contribute to 2021 net revenue.
- 2021 total actual cost of CNY1,356K were mainly composed of:
 - Staff Cost: CNY1.034K, or 76%;
 - G&A Cost: CNY322K, or 24%.
- The above actual cost total was slightly above budgeted cost of CNY1,303K, due to the change in several management positions.
- During 2021, SwissCham Beijing had 3 full time staff, 4 paid interns on average. Since July 2021, changed into 3 full time staff, 3 paid interns.
- By the end of 2021, the actual cash position stands at CNY1,560K.
- The Sino Swiss Business Awards sponsorships, the successful Swiss Traditional Dinner, the membership payments and yearly sponsors increased the cash position in 2021.
- Previous year's bonus payment made decrease the cash position in March. SSBA deposit
 payments decreased cash position in September. Pre-paid sponsorship payment generated
 yearend cash position peak.

Daniel Aellen presents the 2022 Budget:

- 2022 budgeted profit is CNY3K, based on total net revenue of CNY1,360K and total cost of 1,357K.
- Membership fees increase (to be approved at NAGA 2022) may expand revenues in 2022.
- After COVID-19: Challenge to manage expectations and achieve targets
 - Big challenges as China remains de facto cut-off from the rest of the world for the foreseeable future
 - Back to a normal situation partially impacted by the COVID19 recovery
 - Recovering economy vs. uncertainties related to event activities and membership renewal

 We have about more than RMB 1,000k in SwissCham account by the end of March 2021, which makes us able to face the worst case, but we still need to work hard to avoid the worst case.

The outgoing President, Marco Bollier, resigned of his role due to the incapacity to come back to China in the foreseeable future.
